

 <p>Expression</p>	The reader sounds monotone or boring.	The reader has a little bit of expression. Their voice doesn't sound the same all the time but it doesn't always go with the text.  <p>Smoothness</p>	The reader sounds choppy, like they are reading one word at a time.	The reader pauses at inappropriate times. They don't stop at punctuation and sometimes they stop when there is no punctuation.	The reader is pretty good at reading the words in longer groups. The reader usually follows punctuation marks.	The reader reads in long meaningful phrases. The reader always follows punctuation. Their reading sounds smooth and clear.
